Purpose/Attributes:

The Technical Arts Director will be responsible for the oversight of the Pacific Coast Church Media Ministry which includes the technical operation of the AVL systems for all worship services and stage productions on campus. The Technical Arts Director will also recruit, train, and oversee volunteer teams, to work within the Media Ministry ensuring team health and an effective/creative environment. The Technical Arts Director will also be required to maintain and perform the necessary upgrades to ensure effective AVL operations.

Skills, Abilities, Spiritual Health:

- Strong personal commitment to Jesus Christ and alignment with Pacific Coast Church doctrinal statement and vision.
- Experience and/or education sufficient to fulfill the above stated requirements for the Technical Arts Director position.
- Knowledge and high-level competency with ability to operate the following production technologies:
 - Live Video – Direct 3 camera switching. For streaming and video editing (HD-Ross switcher)
 - Lighting – Scene programming. For video and live production (Road Hog)
 - Media Presentation and Projection - (ProPresenter4 and 6)
 - Live Sound – Digital Audio Consoles (Yamaha M7 and others)
- Experience in maintaining and troubleshooting technical systems (Video, Lighting, Presentation, Projection).
- Strong written and verbal communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to multitask a broad range of projects and assignments and meet due dates in a timely fashion.

Priority of Skills Required:

Under current staffing needs in the Technical Arts area, a greater weight of abilities and responsibility for the Technical Arts Director will be in the area of live video capture for streaming, editing of the Sunday's sermon for archiving, lighting for video/live production and volunteer management and training. Knowledge and the ability to build set design and fabrication would be a plus.

Videography experience and the ability to film, edit, and create videos may provide additional hours and income.
